

## Walk of Memories Terms and Conditions

### 1) General

- a. These booking terms and conditions apply to everyone participating in St Helena's Walk of Memories and those who attend as spectators and upon entry you accept these terms and conditions.
- b. There is no minimum age for participants to register. Anyone under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a registered adult who takes responsibility for them at all times throughout the event.
- c. When entering more than one participant into an event, you are deemed the main registrant and will be sent all event communications. It is the main registrants duty to send relevant emails to the supporters they signed up.
- d. Please note there will be a limited amount of windmills for walkers, these are on a first come first served basis.

### 2) Booking process, prices and payment

- a. Registration is non-refundable and non-transferable.
- b. Entry Fees are as follows:
  - i. Child Early Bird - £2.50
  - ii. Adult Early Bird - £5.00
  - iii. Child Standard Rate - £3.50
  - iv. Adult Standard Rate - £8.00
  - v. Child On the Day - £5.00
  - vi. Adult On the Day - £10.00
- c. Places are limited on the Walk of Memories event, and entries are processed in the order we receive them. The closing date for entries is Wednesday 3<sup>rd</sup> July at 9am. All participants wishing to take part after this time will need to sign up and pay on the day of the event.
- d. The early bird offer is available until the 12<sup>th</sup> April at 4pm.
- e. The Walk of Memories event is a St Helena event to raise money for St Helena. We ask that all sponsorship raised is for St Helena, please do not raise money for other charities, trusts or funds.
- f. Any carer taking part to accompany a participant is required to register and pay in the same way as any other participant in order to be covered under St Helena's event insurance.
- g. All funds raised from taking part in this event, including sponsorship will be allocated to general hospice funds to cover all St Helena services.
- h. All participants taking part in Walk of Memories do so at their own risk. In no event shall St Helena be liable for any injuries, loss or damages whatsoever, including indirect, punitive, special, incidental or consequential losses connected with any aspect of this event.
- i. All participants are responsible for their own medical condition. If in doubt about your ability to finish the Walk of Memories or you have a medical condition that might affect your ability to participate, please consult your doctor prior to taking part in the event.
- j. On no account are drugs or alcohol to be brought into the event site or consumed during the event. St Helena reserves the right to refuse entry to anyone we suspect is under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
- k. Jogging or running is not permitted at the Walk of Memories event.
- l. Dogs CAN take part in the event Walk of Memories.
- m. Prams are left to owner's discretion due to the fact the 1 mile route is entirely beach terrain, and could prove difficult for some prams/pushchairs to negotiate.

### 3) Changes to the event

- a. St Helena cannot be held liable for any changes made to the event for safety reasons. Nor can we accept any liability for any changes made to the venue or date of the event.
- b. St Helena reserves the right to alter the start time of the event at any time.

- c. If St Helena cancels the event due to reasons beyond control such as snow, thunderstorms, natural disasters and terrorism, entry fee will not be refunded. An alternative date will be selected and all participants will be admitted to this event.
- d. St Helena reserves the right to cancel this event at any time due to reasons within our control. In the event of this happening, entry fees and sponsorship will be refunded in full.

#### **4) Filming and Photography**

- a. We may film or photograph participants and volunteers taking part or attending events and use such footage or photographs for commercial and/or fundraising use including, but not limited to: advertising, publications, marketing material, merchandising, and other documents made available to the public; and for our sponsors/partners to publicise their involvement or association with the event. Please note, photos and videos may come from a wide range of sources (including spectators), and is sometimes not arranged by St Helena. If approached by a photographer or videographer and you do not wish to be filmed or photographed, please let them know. We do, however, reserve the right to use footage or images supplied to us where you might be included.
- b. No personal details (including names) or anyone under 16-year-old participants will be used in any publicity materials without the written consent of their parent or legal guardian, but we may use images where children are incidentally included, e.g. the warm up or starting line.

#### **5) Data Protection**

- a. The information you provide when you register will be shared only within St Helena. It will not be shared with any other organisation or third party.
- b. By taking part, you agree to St Helena contacting you via telephone, letter or email for any matter relating to your participation in this event.
- c. St Helena may contact you occasionally by post to tell you more about our services and other ways you can help, including opportunities to donate, volunteer or fundraise. You can ask us to stop these communications at any time.
